- ➔ They should integrate indications about their **replication** and **adaptation** to different context in order to maximise commitments and further implementation.

What is a solution ?

Solution's types and criterias

7 criteria will help define the most promising solutions:

1. **Strategic fit with a Forum target:** the solution addresses a specific need or a problem in a way that helps reach the target
2. **Ground-tested:** the solution has already been successfully implemented and shared on the ground
3. **Cost-effectiveness:** the solution yields significant impacts (outputs, outcomes) given the level of investments required (not only financial) and/or when compared to other possible solutions that could be applied to achieve the same target
4. **Demonstrated impact:** the solution's positive impact has been demonstrated and success factors have been identified
5. **Replicability:** the solution has potential for scaling up or replication in other contexts
6. **Commitment:** the solution has convinced a range of stakeholders to commit to implement it in the future
7. **Sustainability:** the solution can continue to deliver tangible positive social, economic and environmental impacts on the long run

- Technical
- Institutional
- Political
- Financial
- Education-related

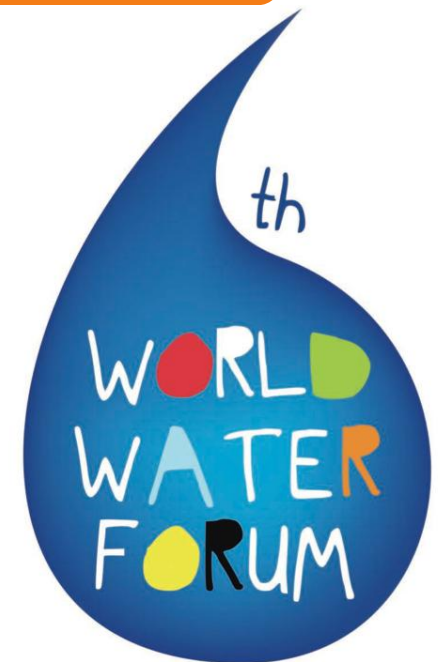

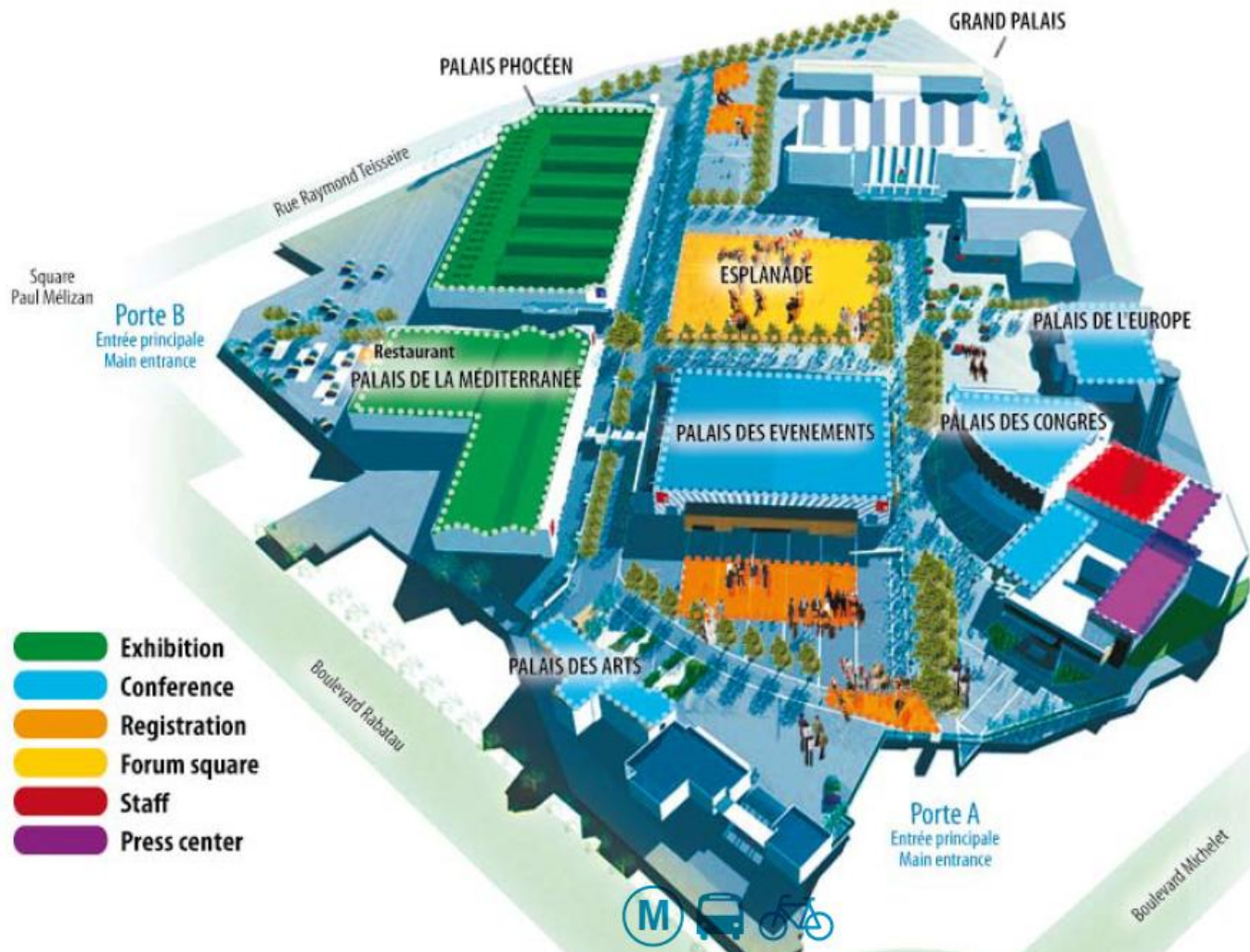

The King Hassan II Great World Water Prize

Deadline for applications is August 31, 2011 !

- Created in May 2000 during the 7th World Water Council Board of Governors meeting, the King Hassan II Great World Water Prize is a joint initiative of the World Water Council and the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco.
- The amount of the prize is **100,000 USD**, offered by the Kingdom of Morocco to an individual, a group of individuals, an institution or an organisation having accomplished a major contribution to the theme of the Prize: "Cooperation and solidarity in the fields of management and development in water resources."
 - The Secretariat for the Prize is based at the World Water Council headquarters.
 - A permanent committee comprised of members from the Kingdom of Morocco and the World Water Council oversees the organisation and promotion of the Prize.
 - A jury including international and Moroccan figures who are knowledgeable about the world of water select the prize winner.
 - The awarding of the Prize has traditionally been held during the Forum's opening ceremony in the presence of the Prince of Morocco.
